Dear Sir:-

I beg to suggest that you bring some influence to bear on McGill football.

I do not think it advisable to have the game completely Americanized as shown by the newspapers. This is a move which will have its influence towards disintegrating our ideals.

Some of us older graduates can not be kept from "lethargic attitude" if the policy of complete Americanization is officially carried on by McGill.

I think this matter is handled better in Toronto and that the tendency should be sidetracked quietly and with tact.

Probably some of the first moves were favored by me 35 years ago; but we had no idea that it would have gone so far.

I don't see why McGill should <sup>adopt</sup> every U.S. fashion of the prize ring methods etc

I played 5 matches against U.S. College teams and have watched games in U.S. for 35 years
