cign policy this opportunity of cheapening the materials of our manufactures and extending our markets is the most important. Next to integrity in our Government and the preservation of our liberties, no subject more deeply concerns the interests of the people. My motion is simply for the appointment of a commission of inquiry. It is so far as I know unanimously approved by the leading commercial and business men of the country without distinction of party, and should meet with the same just consideration from both parties in this House.
