fixing the price or sum or sums of money to be charged or taken for the carriage of any parcel not exceeding one hundred and twenty pounds weight as aforesaid, upon the said Rail-road or any part thereof, or in the said steamboats or vessels, as to them shall seem fit and reasonable; and that the said Company shall from time to time print and stick up, or cause to be printed and stuck up in their office, and in all and every of the places where the Tolls are to be collected, in some conspicuous place there, a printed board or paper ascertaining all the Tolls payable under this Act, and particularising the price or sum or sums of money to be charged or taken for the carriage of such parcels not exceeding one hundred and twenty pounds weight as aforesaid.

Provision as to carriage of Her Majesty's mail, &c.

XLIX. Provided always, and be it enacted, That the said Company shall at all times when thereunto required, by Her Majesty's Deputy Post Master General, the Commander of the Forces, or any person having the Superintendence or Command of any Police Force, earry Her Majesty's Mail, Her Majesty's Naval or Military Forces or Militia, and all Artillery, ammunition, provisions, or other stores for their use, and all Policemen, Constables and others, travelling on Her Majesty's service, on their said Rail-road or in their said steamboats or vessels, on such terms and conditions and under such regulations as the said Company and the said Deputy Post Master General, the Commander of the Forces, or person in Command of any Police Force, respectively, shall agree upon, or if they cannot agree, then on such terms and conditions, and under such regulations as the Governor or person administering the Government shall in Council make: And provided also, that any further enactments which the Legislature of this Province may hereafter deem it expedient to make, with regard to the carriage of the said Mail or Her Majesty's Forces, and other persons and articles as aforesaid, or the rates to be paid for carrying the same, shall not be deemed an infringement of the privileges intended to be conferred by this Act.

Further provision may be made by the Legislature.
