WINNIPEG MARKET HAS LITTLE LIFE

Grain Prices Are, However, Well Maintained—Cash Demand Fairly Good.

WINNIPEG, Feb. 25.—A dull, dead market was the feature on the grain market, business being practically at a standstill. Barring a few transactions in the early hours there was nothing doing. Prices, however, were steady, 1-3/4 to 1-1/2 lower at the opening. Cash demand was fairly good, but there were practically no offerings while exporters were open to buy.

Receipts were heavy, 425 cars in eight for inspection. Cash grain: Wheat, No. 1 northern, 85 1/2; No. 2 do, 82 1/2; No. 3 do, 79 1/2; No. 4 do, 75 1/2; No. 5 do, 73 1/2; No. 6 do, 71 1/2; No. 7 do, 69 1/2; No. 8 do, 67 1/2; No. 9 do, 65 1/2; No. 10 do, 63 1/2; No. 11 do, 61 1/2; No. 12 do, 59 1/2.

European Markets. The Liverpool market closed 1/4 to 1/2 higher on wheat, and 1/4 to 1/2 lower on corn. Paris wheat closed 1/4 to 1/2 lower, Budapest 1/4 lower, and Berlin 3/8 lower.
