An Act respecting the Great Eastern Railway Company.

WHEREAS a position has been presented by the Great Preamble. Eastern Railway Company, hereinafter called "the Company," praying that it may be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said 5 petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

- 1. Section 1 of chapter 43 of the statutes of 1887, and so 1887, c. 43, much of section 6 of chapter 63 of the statutes of 1894 as s. 1 and 1894, c. 63, s. 6 repealed.
- 2. If the railway of the Company, and the branch thereof Time for authorized by section 2 of chapter 43 of the statutes of 1897, completion are not completed before the first day of June A.D. 1905, the extended powers granted for the construction thereof by the Acts 15 relating to the Company shall cease and determine as respects so much of the said railway and branch as then remain uncompleted.
- 3. Section 5 of the Act incorporating the Company, chapter 1882, c. 71, 71 of the statutes of 1882, and section 1 of chapter 61 of the s. 5 and 1883, 20 statutes of 1883, are hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof it is repealed. enacted that the capital stock of the Company shall be one Capital stock million two hundred thousand dollars, divided into twelve reduced. thousand shares of one hundred dollars each.
- 4. The Company may for the purposes of its business:— Powers.

 25 (a) acquire lands, water powers, and water courses, and Water and erect, use, make and manage works, machinery and plant for electric power. the generation, transmission and distribution of electric and other power and energy.

(b) dispose of such surplus power as is not required for the Disposal of 30 purpeses of its business, either directly or by converting the surplus power. same into electric and other power energy.

- (c) acquire any exclusive rights in letters patent, franchises Patent rights or patent rights for the purposes hereby authorized and again dispose of such rights.
- 35 The Company may enter into an agreement with the Agreement Montreal Bridge Company or the Atlantic and Lake Superior with another Railway Company, for conveying or leasing to such company the railway of the Company, in whole or in part, or any rights or powers acquired under the Acts relating to the Company,
