(12) “Governor”, “Governor of Canada”, or “Governor General” means the Governor General for the time being of Canada, or other chief executive officer or administrator for the time being carrying on the Government of Canada on behalf and in the name of the Sovereign, by whatever title he is designated; 5

“Governor in Council.”

(13) “Governor in Council”, or “Governor General in Council” means the Governor General of Canada, or person administering the Government of Canada for the time being, acting by and with the advice of, or by and with the advice and consent of, or in conjunction with the Queen’s Privy Council for Canada; 15

“Great Seal.”

(14) “Great Seal” means the Great Seal of Canada;

“Herein.”

(15) “herein” used in any section shall be understood to relate to the whole enactment, and not to that section only;

“Her Majesty.”

(16) “Her Majesty”, “His Majesty”, “the Queen”, “the King” or “the Crown” means the Sovereign of the United Kingdom, Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, and Head of the Commonwealth; 20

“Her Majesty’s Realms and Territories.”

(17) “Her Majesty’s Realms and Territories” means all realms and territories under the sovereignty of Her Majesty; 25

“Land.”

(18) “land” or “real property” includes lands, tenements, messuages and hereditaments of any tenure, mines, minerals, mineral oils and natural gases, whether held apart from the surface or not, buildings and other structures and any easements, servitudes, rights, privileges or benefits in, over or derived from land; 30

“Holiday.”

(19) “holiday” includes Sundays; New Year’s Day; the Epiphany; Good Friday; the Ascension; All Saints’ Day; Conception Day; Easter Monday; Ash Wednesday; Christmas Day; the birthday or the day fixed by proclamation for the celebration of the birthday of the reigning Sovereign; Victoria Day; Dominion Day; the first Monday in September, designated Labour Day; Remembrance Day; and any day appointed by proclamation to be observed as a day of general prayer or mourning or as a day of public rejoicing or thanksgiving; 40

“Legislature.”

(20) “legislature”, “legislative council” or “legislative assembly” includes the Lieutenant Governor in Council and the Legislative Assembly of the Northwest Territories, as constituted before the 1st day of September, 1905, the Commissioner in Council of the Yukon Territory, and the Commissioner in Council of the Northwest Territories; 50

“Lieutenant governor.”

(21) “lieutenant governor” means the lieutenant governor for the time being, or other chief executive
