The Pullman Car leaving Montreal on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, runs through to Halifax, and that leaving on Tuesday and Thursday to St. John.

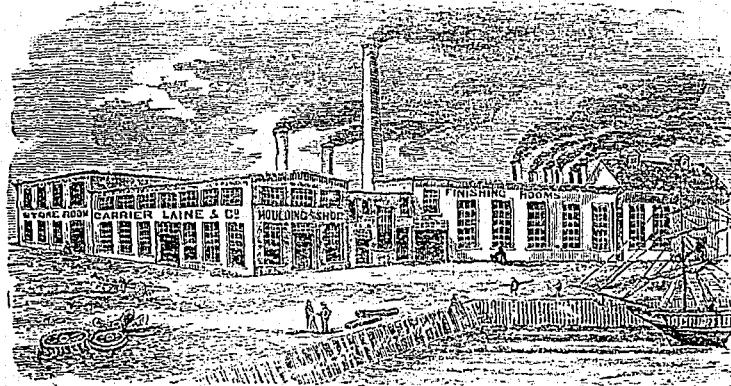
