

receive and receipt for all moneys paid to him by the Trustees, Chief Engineer and others; keep a correct account of the same in books provided for that purpose; and pay all orders properly drawn upon him by the Trustees, which shall be his vouchers for the same. He shall, in the months of February and August of each year, render a report of his receipts and disbursements, on behalf of said Fund, to the Board of Delegates. He shall give good and sufficient bonds, in the sum of five hundred dollars, (\$500) for the faithful discharge of his trust. His books shall, at all times, be open to the inspection of the Trustees, and the Committee on Finance of the Board of Delegates, and shall be promptly delivered up to his successor in office.

## ARTICLE XXI.

### UNIFORMS.

In order to designate Engineers and Company officers at fires, or alarms thereof, the Chief and Assistant Engineers shall wear white caps, with their grade of office painted thereon. Foremen and Assistant Foremen shall wear white fronts to their caps, with the number of the Company and their grade of office painted thereon; and if a Hook and Ladder Company, a hook and ladder, or a Hose Company, a coil of hose, in addition to the number of the Company and their grade of office.
