

V.

That all the Classical Pupils shall attend the instruction of the English Master at such times and to such extent as the Principal Preceptor shall direct ; except in cases in which on the request of a Parent or Guardian the visiting Committee shall otherwise appoint.

VI.

That the Tuition money of the Classical Pupils be £6 per Annum ; £1 of which be paid over to the English Master for every Scholar, who from the higher department of the Seminary may attend his instructions ; and that the rate of tuition for such Pupils as do not attend the Classical Master be £4 per Annum.

VII.

That the Pupils in both departments be regularly divided into Classes according to their proficiency ; and that these Classes be all regularly seated at proper forms, there to pursue their studies and exercises till called on to attend the Preceptor for
