There will be a billion's worth of gold during the next five years, and this will create, at least, a billion's worth of credit money. The result will be a gold inflation, and everything will rise in value."

MORE GIRLS TO BE COMMITTED.

Industrial Schools Association Complaint of Magistrate's Apathy.

Mr. Stapleton Caldecott, president of the Industrial Schools Association, is a member of the Board of Management of the Industrial Schools Association. Principal Hassard of the Victoria Industrial School, reports that four boys had during the month been received from the County of Simcoe, and three from the County of Bruce. Two boys who escaped last July had been captured, one at Owen Sound, the other near Guelph. Mrs. Caldecott read the report of the Alexandra School for Girls, from which it appeared that there is accommodation for 40 girls, while only 20 are in the institution. The chairman regretted the disinclination of magistrates to commit girls to the school. Many girls were going to run through lack of supervision. The same disinclination was noticed in regard to the boys. Mr. Caldecott said the attention of Staff Inspector Archibald had several times been called to this state of affairs, but with the shop girls' regulations. It was decided that a deputizing party to the Police Magistrate and lay a statement of the grievance before him.
