of the Halifax dry dock, informed the Telegraph-Journal last evening.

Mr. Brookfield, who is at present connected with the Brookfield Construction Company, Ltd., of Halifax, accompanied by Henry Roper, general manager of the company, were taken out to Courtenay Bay yesterday to inspect the work there. Both these men were intimately connected with the Halifax dockyards, Mr. Brookfield, as general manager for thirteen years previous to the expropriation of the shipyards by the Federal Government, and Mr. Roper, in connection with the construction company had a large part in the building of the dock.

When asked how it compared with other docks he had seen, Mr. Brookfield said that he had spent six or seven years in Scotland and England, previous to assuming the management of the Halifax dockyards, studying conditions there, and there was no doubt that the claims for the size of this dock were justified. It was admirably equipped, he said, and he felt sure it would fulfill the expectations of those who fathered it, if not in the present abnormal times in the shipbuilding industry, at least when shipping got back to a normal basis.
