WIDOW WINS \$100,000 CASE

Proves She is Common-Law Wife
of Supreme Court Justice's Son
(N. Y. Times)

By proving herself to be the widow of George G. Barnard, son of the late Supreme Court Justice George G. Barnard, who died in Amityville, L. I., on Dec. 26, 1915, Mary G. Shelly won \$100,000 yesterday through a verdict handed down in the supreme court at Mineola, L. I. Barnard inherited a trust fund of \$100,000 from his grandfather, John Anderson. He had converted into a common-law wife, through the Farmers' Loan and Trust Company. He specified that, at his death, the principal was to go to his wife, if he had one, or to his children. When Barnard died, the trust company paid over \$47,500 of the money in her name. Then Mrs. Shelly appeared and said that she and Barnard contracted a common law marriage on Dec. 18, 1901, and was entitled to the money. A jury decided that she was right.

Mrs. Shelly testified that she became engaged to Barnard while walking in Riverside Drive, Manhattan, one morning in July, 1901. Both had been married and divorced, Barnard having been the defendant in his case, and Mrs. Shelly the plaintiff in hers. On Dec. 18, 1901, Mrs. Shelly testified, at her home in Providence, R. I., that she and Barnard had a common-law marriage ceremony, and she testified that they had been married. They lived as man and wife in many different places and continually thereafter.

The case will probably be appealed. Meanwhile the trust company, it was announced, will start suit against Barnard's children to recover the money paid over to them.
