Such appointments to have the force of a Conference appointment.

75. That the address of the retiring President of the Conference be delivered on the evening of the first day of Conference.

76. That the thanks of the Conference be given to the President and the Secretaries of the Conference, to the Conference reporter, and the Rev. J. Shuttleworth, for their valuable services during Conference.

77. That the Rev. W. McClure be re-appointed tutor of the Theological Institute.

78. That the Board of Education be the Revds. the President, J. C. Watts, T. Goldsmith and the Tutor, with brethren Aikman, Blake and Dr. Salter.
