1st. WITNESS:-

No. A-35033 Cpl. Sommerville, J.D. of the No.1. Road Constr. Coy., R.C.E. (OS); having been duly sworn states:-

"I, A35033 Cpl. Sommerville, J.D., Cpl. in charge of "A" Section of the No.1. Road Constr. Coy., R.C.E., to which the accused Spr. Feldman, L. belongs, called the roll at 0700 hours 6th. April 1942, and found that he was not present. I reported him as absent ~~without~~ leave on the section parade state. I was not present when he returned to his Billets. I did not see the accused from the 6th. April 42, until I saw him in his billets on the 24th. April 1942".
