That this Meeting, recognizing that great principle of the Christian Religion, that, unaided by the Holy Ghost, man's best efforts are powerfest in extending the Kingdom of our Lord Jesus Christ in the world, is resolved to be more frequent and fervent in its supplications for the promised outpouring of the Spirit on Missionaries themselves, and on the fields of labour occupied by them.

Moved by the Rev. EDMUND BOTTERELL; seconded by the Rev. William Sourie; supported by the Rev. B. Slight:

3. That this Meeting, conscious that however much may have already been done towards the conversion of the world, much more yet remains to be done ere "the uttermost parts of the earth can be given to the Son of God for his possession"; and encouraged by the numerous and pathetic calls for additional assistance which are continually arising from various parts of the Heathen world, solemnly pledges itself to more liberal contributions, and to renewed endeavours to promote its evangelization.

Moved by the Rev. Hugh Montgomery; seconded by the Rev. Robert Graham:

4. That the cordial thanks of this Meeting be presented to all the Collectors of the various Branch Societies in connection with this Auxiliary, for their self-denying and zealous efforts to promote, during the past year, the interests of the Parent Society.

Moved by the Rev. Edmund S. Ingalls; seconded by the Rev. Thomas Campbell:

5. That the following Ministers and Lay Gentlemen be the Officers and Committee of this Auxiliary for the ensuing year. (See page 3.)

Moved by the Rev. M. Lang; seconded by the Rev. J. B. Brownell:
