

Ashes, Timber and Lumber of all kinds, round, hewed and sawed, unmanufactured in whole or in part, Firewood, Plants, Shrubs and Trees, Pelts, Wool, Fish Oil, Rice, Broom Corn, and Bark, Gypsum, ground or unground, hewn, or wrought, or unwrought, Burr or Grindstones, Dye Stuffs, Flax, Hemp and Tow unmanufactured, unmanufactured Tobacco, Rags.

The following Articles, being the growth, produce, or manufacture of the United Kingdom, the British North American Provinces, and Prince Edward Island, are admitted free of Duty under the Reciprocity Act:—

Animals, Beef, Pork, Biscuit, Bread, Butter, Cocoa Paste, Corn or Grain of all kinds, Flour and Bread Stuffs, Fish, fresh or salted, dried or pickled, Fish Oil, Furs or Skins, the produce of Fish or creatures living in the sea, Gypsum, Horns, Poultry, Plants, Shrubs and Trees, Potatoes and Vegetables of all kinds. Seeds of all kinds, Apples, Pelts, Skins, Furs, or Tails, undressed, Wood, viz:—Boards, Plank, Staves, Timber and Firewood.

The following Articles, being the growth, produce, or manufacture of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, and Prince Edward Island, are Admitted free of Duty, under the Reciprocity Act:—

Grain and Bread Stuffs of all kinds, Vegetables, Fruits, Seeds, Hay and Straw, Hops, Animals, salted and fresh Meats, Butter, Cheese, Chocolate and other preparations of Cocoa, Lard, Tallow, Hides, Horns, Wool, undressed Skins and Furs of all kinds, Ores of all kinds, Iron in Pigs and Blooms, Copper, Lead in Pigs, Grindstones and Stones of all kinds, Earth, Coals, Lime, Oebres, Gypsum ground or unground, Rock Salt, Wood, Bark, Timber and Lumber of all kinds, Firewood, Ashes, Fish, Fish Oil, viz:—Train Oil, Spermaceti Oil, Head Matter and Blubber, Fins and Skins the produce of Fish or Creatures living in the Sea.

ACTS OF THE LOCAL LEGISLATURE, 1856.

1—An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain Duties on Goods, Wares, and Merchandize, imported into this Colony and its Dependencies.

2—An Act for granting to Her Majesty a sum of money for constructing and repairing Roads, Streets, and Bridges in this Colony.

3—An Act to regulate the Inland Posts of this Colony.

4—An Act for the Encouragement of Education.

5—An Act to authorize the Governor in Council to erect Light Houses on the Coast of this Colony, and for other purposes.

6—An Act to authorise the Consolidation of £68,607 5s. 4d., of the Public Debt of this Colony.

7—An Act for granting to Her Majesty a sum of money for defraying the Expenses of the Civil Government of this Colony for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1856, and for other purposes.
