Committee of the whole House breaking up for want of a Quorum, or by the House adjourning for want of a Quorum, the Order or Orders so lost, shall be taken up in succession, as the first business to be proceeded on, at the next meeting of the House.

PRIVILEGES.

RESOLVED, That whenever any matter of Privilege arises, it shall be immediately taken into consideration.

Note.—The Rules passed by the House for regulating the proceedings on Contested Elections, although not resemble are become null, as the Provincial Act of the 48th Geo. III. chapter 31, provides therefor; they are for that reason omitted in the present selection.
