I beg to attach a resolution of the Pasqua Band asking that a sum not exceeding \$200.00 of the Band funds be used for building the roads in their Reserves. These Indians appreciate the assistance given by the Department and have voted this amount to supplement that allowed from the Department and permit the construction of more roads. I would recommend it be allowed.

I am, also, attaching requisition for material needed in the proposed road work in the Agency amounting to \$73.38. This will leave a balance of \$726.62 to pay for labor and I would recommend that an accountable cheque for this amount be sent to Mr. Booth to cover the cost of labor.

With reference as to roads it is proposed to build, they are as follows:

- Pasqua:
  - Re-grading from the Agency to the Valley and from the Agency to Muscow.
- Sioux:
  - Grading the hill and road through the Valley.
- Muscowpetung:
  - Grading the road east and west through the Reserve.
- Piapot:
  - Grading the Valley road and hill.
- Assinaboine:
  - Grading the road and west from the Agency to the boundary.
