It does not appear from the letters or estracts transmitted by Mesteers that den John Collione intended to purchase or to rent the property of the late M Cornatinger at the expense afthe Indian Department; the cost of the purchase was to be defrayed from the funds of the dociety for the propagation of the Gospel, and an appeal. was made to the generosity of the Impereal yourn ment because the dociety had not the means topay £ 400. (vede M Matthews letter appendix Nos.) of the Lint: povernor had intended to pay the amount from the funds of the Indian Department, he could have issued his Warrant nuthout appealing to the Sunday of State, as in the cases where he allows on his authorety £ 150 + £ 100, and again (M' Mathens letter 24 april . 1834) "you mult be "allowed a small sum of money from the Indian Department to fut the house in external repair It was is puted that the Indians would benefit spiritually from the establishment of the Mession and it was right they should contribute to its maintenance.
