
Ottawa, 19th April, 1911.

SIR,

With reference to your letter of the 23rd ultimo, I have to inform you that you should have submitted to the Department for approval the requisitions for drugs therein referred to before having them filled. If they were found satisfactory the Department would have given you authority to order the articles from Mr Adams.

I have also to remind you that medicines are only supposed to be supplied to missionaries for ~~the~~ Indians dispensing to Indians who are not under the care of a physician. If there is a doctor appointed to care for the Indians it is expected that he will furnish all necessary drugs.
