With reference to your letter of the 23rd ultimo. I have to inform you that you should have submitted to the Decment for approval the requisitions for drugs therein referre to before having them filled. If they were found satisfactors, the Department would have given you authority to order the articles from Mr Adams.

I have also to remind you that medicines are only supposed to be supplied to missionaries for the maximalians dispensing to Indians who are not under the care of a physician if there is a doctor appointed to care for the Indians it is expected that he will furnish all necessary druged
