I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your 1 of the 28th ultimo and in reply have to say that the lands of the Indians are held in trust by this Depar ment for them and cannot be granted without fair con pensation therefor.

You should forward to the Department copie of your right of way plans showing the lands in Indi Reserves required. The plane should be on tracing of accompanied by two blue prints of each plan. The tr ings should be signed by a responsible officer of yo company as well as by the surveyor who made the surv

On the receipt of these action will be tak on them and you will be further advised. I may here say that entry will not be allowed on an Indian Rese for construction purposes until the right of way has been arranged for with this Department.
