(5) Passage of Assault Forces from departure area which was 15 miles south of Isle of Wight was covered by 16 Destroyers and 50 Coastal Craft. 4 A/S groups (including E G 11 and 12) operated in approaches to Channel. In addition 6 support groups (E G 1, 2, 5, 6, 9, 15) are employed in Western approaches English Channel and Bay of Biscay.

(7) 10 swept channels are being established between
