

USEFUL KNOWLEDGE.

1. How many days are there in the year?—365, and every fourth year 366; and this fourth year is called Leap Year.

2. How many months are there in the year?—12: January, February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November, December.

3. How many days are there in a month?—30 or 31. The month of February has 28 days, and in every fourth year 29: the addition of this day forms leap year.

4. Name the months having 30 days, and those having 31.—Seven months in the year have 31 days: January, March, May, July, August, October, December. Four months of the year have 30 days: April, June, September, November. February has 28 or 29 days.

5. How many weeks are there in the year?—There are in the year 52 weeks, each of 7 days: Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday.

6. When does the year begin?—On the first day of January.

7. When does it end?—On the 31st of December.

8. How many seasons are there in the year?—Four: Spring, Summer, Autumn, and Winter.

9. How many months in each season?—Three months.

10. In which month does spring commence?—Spring commences in the month of March.

11. In which month does summer commence?—Summer commences in the month of June.

12. In which month does autumn commence?—Autumn commences in the month of September.

13. In which month does winter commence?—Winter commences in the month of December.

14. You have said that a week has 7 days; how many hours in one day?—There are 24 hours in one day.

15. How do you divide the day?—The day is divided into four parts: morning, noon, evening, night. Twice 12 hours are counted as one day.

16. How many minutes in an hour?—An hour contains 60 minutes.

17. How many seconds in a minute?—A minute contains 60 seconds.
