Consider, fifthly, in the sufferings of thy Saviour, the infinite malice, the unparalleled heinousness of mortal sin, which could not be cancelled but by the blood of the Son of God. This is the chief lesson which thy Saviour desires to teach thee, from the chair of the cross; thou canst not please him better than by studying it well. O! never then be so ungrateful as to crucify him again by mortal sin. O! suffer not that monster to live in thee, for the destroying of which Christ himself would die.
