ADMISSION.

The lectures of the College are open, according to the terms of affiliation, to all undergraduates of the University of Toronto. Students for the ministry, who desire to become full members of the College, will be examined by the Faculty, with reference to their intellectual, moral and spiritual fitness for the work of the ministry, and their literary preparation for the courses of study that they may propose to undertake. *Each candidate for the ministry will be required to present a license to preach from the church of which he is a member.*

Ministers and Laymen, who desire to fit themselves for Christian work, but whose circumstances will not permit them to complete any one of the prescribed Courses, and who come properly recommended, will be welcomed to any of the classes, for a longer or shorter period, as their circumstances may dictate.
