Common seeds of all kinds to be found in the market, such as the Fife wheat, Golden Vine pea, Angus oat, and various sorts of potatoes, Clover seed, Timothy seed, Spring Tares, &c., selected and shipped at 12 1/2c per bushel advance on cost. We do not keep the common sorts on hand, but will select, when our applicants wish to change seed from one section to another.
