part of the Parish of Dumfries, in the County of York, into a separate Town or Parish, and to alter the name of the said Parish, to which they desire the concurrence of this House.

The said Bill was read a first time.

ORDERED, That the said Bill stand for a strond reading to-morrow.

The Honorable Mr. Johnston, by leave, presented a Petition from Thomas Leavitt and Company, of the City of Saint John, Merchants, praying an excess of Duty paid at the Treasury Office in 1842, may be allowed them.

ORDERED, That the Petition be received, and lie on the table.
