VAUVERT, France, Thursday .- The citizens of this town have started a subscription for the purpose of erecting at Quebec, a statue of General Montcalm, the French commander, who was mortally wounded at the battle of the Plains of Abraham in 1759. Montcalm was born in Vauvert.

It has been decided to have tw statues of Montcalm made. One is to be kept in France and the other will probably be presented to Quebec. About 8,000 francs have already been subscribed.
