The qualification of electors under Stove, Furnace and Blacksmith the provisions of the Dominion Elections Act requires that every voter, whether male or female, shall be:

(a) A British subject;

the writ of election;

(b) Twenty-one years of age; (c) Shall have ordinarily resided in Canada for one year immeditely preceeding the date of the issue of

(d) Shall have ordinarily resided in the electorial district for the two months immediately preceeding

(e) Is not expressly denied the right to vote.
