O'N the recommendation of the Henoralde the Minister of Customs, and under the provisions of the 8th and 5th sections of the Act passed in the Session of the Parliament of Canada, held in the Sist year of Her Majesty's Reign, chaptered 6 and intituted "An Act respecting the Customs," His Excellency, by and with the advice of the Queen's Privy Council for Canada, has been pleased to order, and it is nerely ordered, that the Ont Port of Penciangore (now known as Kincardine), attached to the Port of Goderich, in the Province of Ontario, be and it is hereby constituted a Port of Entry and a Warehousing Port, the same to take effect tom the First day of October, 1875.
