

The decline in New England landings in recent years affected the individual states in an almost proportionate manner, with the exception of Connecticut. Growth in total value of landings occurred for all individual states.

With respect to major fishing ports, New Bedford has fared relatively well in terms of both volume and total value. This is, again, a reflection of relatively good landings of scallops in recent years.
