Excelsior,

I acknowledge receipt of your letter No. ADA-0011 of 12 January 1982 which reads as follows:

"I have the honour to refer to the discussions between our officials concerning the employment of dependents of employees of one Government assigned to official duty in the other country and wish to propose an Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of Finland in the following terms:

1. The two Governments agree that, on the basis of reciprocity, dependents of employees of one Government assigned to official duty in the other country as members of a diplomatic mission, members of a consular post, or members of a mission to an international organization will receive authority to accept employment in the receiving State.

2. In this agreement, the word 'dependents' shall include the spouse, children, and other persons who are dependent on the employee for support, and who are not employed in the receiving State.
