HER ROYAL HIGHNESS THE PRINCESS ROYAL

SEPTEMBER 29 - OCTOBER 25

1955

Her Royal Highness the Princess Royal will arrive in Quebec City on Thursday, September 29, by the Empress of France. She will visit the following cities of Canada: Quebec City, September 29 - October 2; Montreal, October 2 - October 6; Kingston, October 7 - October 9; Ottawa, October 9 - October 11; Toronto, October 12 - October 13; Niagara Falls, October 13 - October 14; Winnipeg, October 14 - October 15; Victoria, October 15 - October 21; Vancouver, October 21 - October 23; Montreal, October 23 - October 25. The Princess Royal will sail aboard the Empress of France from Montreal on October 25.

During her stay in Canada, the Princess Royal will be accompanied by Miss Gwynedd Lloyd, Lady-in-Waiting; Major Geoffrey Eastwood, A.D.C.; Mr. Ph. Thibault, Department of External Affairs; Major L. J. Morrell, Royal Canadian Corps of Signals, A.P.C.; Captain L. G. Boiron, C.E., R.C.R.; and Inspector H. Dick, R.C.M.P.

ACREDITATION

Members of the press, still and newsreel photographers and radio and TV commentators, broadcast crews and cameramen who are covering any part of the tour should at all times be ready to provide their normal means of identification to any authorities who may ask to see them. No special accreditation tags and cards are being issued for this visit.

TRANSPORTATION

A car will be at the disposal of Mr. Thibault in every city the Princess Royal will visit. Members of the out of town press who find themselves without transportation may join Mr. Thibault in his car.
