DAMAGE TO CORN NOT IRREPARABLE

Heavy Selling Checked Wild
Flurry at Chicago—Other
Grains Off.

CHICAGO, July 30.—Big trading and
slight action of prices kept excitement
at high pitch today in corn.
There was sharp difference of opinion
as to a further upturn in the market.
showing having been predicted. The
close was nervous, 1-4c to 3-8c above

Broadly speaking, the country bought
corn; city speculators sold. In the end
the buyers were outnumbered by the
sellers. Dry hot weather over the entire
belt brought such a volume of orders
to purchase that the opening was un-
usually wild, prices ranging as much
as a cent apart at the same moment
among brokers almost at each other's
elbows. It was at this time that the
top level of the day was reached.

Wheat gave way as soon as it was
evident that the upward rush of the
corn market had been halted, at least
for the time being. Reports of generous
threshing returns from the winter crop
had much to do with the weakness of
wheat. So, too, did the big primary
receipts, 2,022,000 bushels, against 1-
438,000 bushels a year ago.
