

(e.) The expression "Court of Appeal" includes the following courts: R.S.C., c. 174, s. 2 (h) altered.

(i) In the Province of Ontario, any division of the High Court of Justice;

(ii) In the Province of Quebec, the Court of Queen's Bench, appeal side;

(iii) In the Provinces of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and British Columbia, and in the North-West Territories, the Supreme Court;

(iv) In the Province of Prince Edward Island, the Supreme Court of Judicature;

(v) In the Province of Manitoba, the Court of Queen's Bench

(f.) The expression "District, county or place" includes any division of any Province of Canada for purposes relative to the administration of justice in criminal cases. Id. s. 2 (f).

(g.) The expression "Document of title to goods" includes any bill of lading, India warrant, dock warrant, warehouse-keeper's receipt, warrant or order for the delivery or transfer of any goods or valuable thing, bought and sold note, or any other document used in the ordinary course of business as proof of the possession or control of goods, authorizing or purporting to authorize, either by indorsement or by delivery, the possessor of such document to transfer or receive any goods thereby represented or therein mentioned or referred to. R.S.C., c. 164, s. 2 (a).

(h.) The expression "Document of title to lands" includes any deed, map, paper or parchment, written or printed, or partly written and partly printed, being or containing evidence of the title, or any part of the title, to any real property, or to any interest in any real property, or any notarial or registrar's copy thereof, or any duplicate instrument, memorial, certificate or document authorized or required by any law in force in any part of Canada respecting registration of titles, and relating to such title. Id. s. 2 (b).

(i.) The expression "Explosive substance" includes any materials for making an explosive substance; also any apparatus, machine, implement, or materials used, or intended to be used, or adapted for causing, or aiding in causing, any explosion in or with any explosive substance; and also any part of any such apparatus, machine or implement. R.S.C., c. 174, s. 2 (b).

(j.) The expression "Finding of the indictment" includes also exhibiting an information and making a presentment. R.S.C., c. 174, s. 2 (d).

(k.) The expression "Having in possession," includes not only having in one's own personal possession, but also knowingly. Adapted from R.S.C., c. 164, s. 2 (l); c. 165, s. 2; c. 167, s. 2; c. 171, s. 3; 50 & 51 V., c. 45, sec. 2 (e).

(i.) having in the actual possession or custody of any other person; and

(ii.) having in any place (whether belonging to or occupied by one's self or not) for the use or benefit of one's self or of any other person.
