VILLE ST LOUIS.

An incorporated town adjoining the north limits of Montreal, bounded on the north by the parish of Sault au Recollet, east by the Denis ward, Montreal, south by Mount Royal av., and west by the limits of Outremont. The town contains a Romain Catholic church, the Deaf and Dumb male institute, a coal and a large provision warehouse, and a saw mill. The town is lighted with electricity, and has an electric car service supplied by the Montreal Park & Island Railway Co. Population 4500.

(Incorporated in 1897).

Incorporated town in the county of Hochelaga. It is bounded on the north by the LaSalle canal, south by the Aqueduct, on the east by the line of the G.T.R. from the said canal at the buildings of the Aqueduct, on the west by parish of Lachine. There are several mills and large manufacturing establishments. Distant from Coteau St Pierre 1 mile, from St Henry 1 mile, from Montreal Post 3 miles. Mail twice a day. Population 8,000.

FORMERLY COTE ST ANTOINE.

In the county of Hochelaga, district of Montreal, and adjoining the western limits of the city of Montreal. This flourishing town is rapidly increasing in population, and is becoming the favorite residential locality of the merchants of Montreal. The town is supplied with electricity, has an ample water supply and thorough system of drainage, the streets are well laid out and macadamized. A very efficient police force and

fire brigade fully equipped with all necessary apparatus is maintained for the protection of the town. The electric cars, which traverse the town, afford rapid communication with the city of Montreal. The new observatory and arboretum of McGill University will be located on the Mountain, within the town limits. Mail twice daily. Population about 8,000.
