A Grand Voyer guilty of wilful neglect or default of duty to himself or his Deputy, forfeits a sum not exceeding twenty pounds nor less than five at the discretion of the Court imposing the fine, one half to the Prosecutor and the other to his Majesty. But the Action against him must be brought within six months after the offence, and if Judgment is given in such action in favor of the Grand Voyer, the Prosecutor is to pay triple Costs.—*Sec. 34.*
