If you prefer Domestie Missions you have the Indian Missions in the North West and Labrador, and the Missions in Algoma, Ruperts Land and elsewhere in our Dominion.

If you wish to contribute to Missionary object still nearer, you have the Board of Home Missions, or if you prefer it, the Colonial and Continental Society's Missions, the missionaries of which are all doing duty within this Province.

If you are more interested in Educational matters, there are Colleges and Educational institutions within Canada, the system of Education at one or more of which would meet your views, and merit your support, and assistance, which no doubt every college requires.

If you take a less extended view and desire that your contribution should be expended within the diocese, you have in addition to those missions I have mentioned, the fund for the Widow's and Orphan's of the clergy, the Clergy Superannuation Fund, and the Episcopal Endowment Fund.

The fund for the Widow's and Orphan's is very small, each Widow last year received \$115.00 only, a sum entirely inadequate for her support, and few of the Clergy in this diocese are in a position to make provision for their wives and children, their stipends are so small.

The fund for the support of the Superannuated Clergy is not sufficient for the purpose. The pension now established varies from \$250 for those who have served 15 years to \$400 for those who have served 30 years in the diocese. This is a small sun, and liable to further reduction if more of the Clergy become entitled to a pension, and the fund is not increased.

If none of these subjects excite your sympathies, you have the affairs of your own parish to consider, and to which you can give assistance. Is there no debt connected with your church or parish? Does the church look weather-beaten and shabby and require repairs or improvements? Have you a Sunday School building, and a Rectory, or are either of them required in your parish? To all or any of these things you can contribute. In my opinion from a lay stand point I consider the institution and efficient maintenance of one or more Sunday
