# **PREMIERS AIM** TO GIVE POLAND

Giolitti and Lloyd George To Submit Their Proposals To France.

OFFICIAL STATEMENT

Conference At Lucerne Ends With Cordial Greetings To Millerand.

LUCERNE, Switzerland. Aug. 23.—
Premier Lloyd George of Great Britain and Premier Giolitti of Italy have adopted proposals to be submitted to France for allied action to secure Poland free and unrestricted use of Danzig and its communications in accordance with the Versailles treaty, it was announced officially here today. cordance with the Versailles treaty, it was announced officially here today. The conference between Mr. Lloyd George and Signor Giolitti concluded this evening, when the premiers sent the following telegram to M. Millerand, the French foreign minister: "In finishing our Lucerne conference we send you a cordial salute and look forward with pleasure to the earliest occasion when both of us can meet your excellency."





OTTAWA, Aug. 23 .- (Canadian Press) The last pensions checks before the oming into effect of the new scale are now being issued. These are the August pension checks, which have been going out from the pensions board offices here since August 10. The September checks will carry the increases recommended by the special parliamentary committee, and which were the basis of amendments to the pensions act made during last session. Canada's pension bill for the twelve months ending ing August 31, this year, will be, it is estinated, in the neighborhood of \$25,000,000. With the increases going into effect on September 1, of this year, it is estimated that the pensions bill for the next twelve months will be increased by \$10,000,000, and the total will be \$35,000,000. 


