

In the N. S. Steel & Coal Company's shipyard at New Glasgow on Monday, George Bradbury was killed when a heavy piece of timber fell on him. Tarrsboro, N. S., has word that the tern schooner Coral Leaf, Capt. Mc-Dade from Port Greville for Barry, with deals, was torpedoed and set on fire by a German submarine, that the crew landed safely and that the vessel was subsequently towed into an Irish port.
