SEEK ON OCEAN BED CAUSE OF EARTHQUAKES

U. S. Navy Department and Carnegie Institution Join in Use of a New Depth

Two American destroyers—the Hull and the Corry—have been equipped with this novel apparatus at San Francisco from which port they are about to start on voyages during which they will make about 7,000 miles of continuous soundings between San Francisco and Point Descanso on the Mexican coast. They will make a complete map of the ocean floor along the California and Mexican coasts, and it is believed by scientists in Washington that this new survey of the sea bottom, which can be made almost automatically by the newly perfected sonic finder, may reveal the cause and effect of siesmic disturbances along the West coast.

It is probable that after the survey along the Mexican and California coasts has been completed naval destroyers will be sent to the Chilean coast to measure the depth of the ocean moor there and ascertain to what extent there has been a shifting of the continental shelf in connection with the recent Chilean earthquakes.

The Hull and Corry are attached to the Pacific fleet. They were diverted from their regular work and sent to the Mare Island Navy Yard for the installation of the new sonic device. It cost the navy about \$18,000 to intsall the apparatus in each.

Two methods of obtaining soundings will be used—one for depths up to 540 feet and the other for greater depths. The first is known as the angle method, it uses the ship's propellers as a sound device, and the echo is received in a compensator from the sound receivers. The depths scale is graduated by ontaining several points on a curve when the set is calibrated. After calibration the depths may be read directly from the scale.

The second, or deep sea method, uses the speed of sound in water as a means of measuring the depths. An impuse is sent out on the oscillator. The elapsed time between the sending and receiving of the oscillation is recorded automatically when the echo completes the electrical circuit. The apparatus to be used will be a standard navy sound receiver, a submarine signal company's Fessenden type of sound oscillator for transmitting sound signals and the navy sonic depth finder.




