## LAWS AND REGULATIONS

OF THE

## fritish and Foreign Pible Society.

I. The designation of the Society shall be THE BRITISH ND FOREIGN BIBLE SOCIETY, of which the main object shall be to encourage a wider circulation of the Holy Scriptures ithout note or comment; the only copies in the language of the United Kingdom, to be circulated by the Society, hall be the Authorized Version.

II. This Society shall add its endeavours to those imployed by other Societies, for circulating the Scriptures brough the British Dominion; and shall also, according to a sability, extend its influence to other countries, whether thristian, Mohammedan or Pagañ.

III. Each subscriber of One Guinea annually shall be a

IV. Each subscriber of Ten Guineas at one time shall be Member for life.

V. Each subscriber of Twenty-five Guineas annually hall be a Governor.

VI. Each subscriber of Fifty Pounds at one time, or who hall, by one additional payment, increase his original subcription to Fifty Pounds, shall be a Governor for life.

VII. Governors shall be entitled to attend and vote at.

VIII. An Executor, paying a bequest of Fifty Pounds hall be a Member for life; or, of One Hundred Pounds, a overnor for life.
