During the inspection I found under the bed of the accused, whom I now recognize, a box similar to a barrack box. The accused upon being questions about it said it didn't belong to him and I asked him who it did belong to and he said a man by the name of Duthree. I didn't know of anyone in the he said a man by the name of Duthree. I didn't know of anyone in the Coy by that name and questioned the accused regarding the box. He stated that he had only been in the hut approx a week and didn't know where the box came from. No one in the hut seemed to know anything about it and I had it removed, to the Unit Orderly Room. This is the box. It was securely locked with a padlock and hasp. In the unit Orderly Room I personally forced the box open in the presence of the Orderly Room Cpl. The box then had all the contents which are in it now here today. Also in the box I discovered a carton added to a Cpl Sherring of our unit. BOX AND CONTENTS MARKED EXHIBIT "A". As Cpl Sherring was on strength of our unit but at that time on leave, and in case it was his property I turned the matter over to the OC. CROSS EXAMINED Are you sure the box belonged to the accused? I didn't say it did, but I found it under his bed. Who accompanied you to the Orderly Room? A. The Orderly Sgt. Who was with you during the inspection? Lopl Donofrio and the Orderly Sgt.
