

Memorandum

For the Deputy Superintendent General

Ottawa, May 6, 1913.

With reference to the meaning of the Imperial Oil Company, I desire to state that the portion of St. Andrews St. in the town of Sarnia which it is desired to close is situated in a part of the Sarnia Indian Reserve which was surrendered and subdivided for sale many years ago. All the property adjoining the said portion of street has been sold and there is no other property hald by this Department that will be affected by the said closing.

If the Town Council takes the requisite steps to close the street, it has been held in cases immediately contiguous that the fee is then held by this Department, and consequently application has been made here.

A few years ago in the last of the cases referred to \$590. per acre was charged. On consulting with Mr.Orr we are of the opinion that \$600. per acre should now be charged. I beg to submit the draft hereunder addressed to Messrs Hanna, Lesever & McKinley for your approval.
