XXI. And he it enacted, that if any person shall wilfully Penalty for 5 remove, destroy, damage, fraudulently alter or in any way injuring injure any pipe, pedestal, post, plug, lamps or other apparatus ting Gas, &c. or thing belonging to the Company or to any person or shall wilfully extinguish any of the public lamps or lights or waste or improperly use or suffer to be used any of the Gas supplied 10 by the Company, he shall forfeit and pay for every such offence the penalty and expenses mentioned in the nineteenth section of this Act.

XXII. And be it enacted, that if any person shall carelessly or accidentally break, throw down or damage any Companymay 15 meter, pipe, pedestal or lamp supplied by or belonging to the ges for injury to meters, &c. Company or any person, or keep the light or lights burning to meters, &c. or excessive not on demand make satisfaction to the Company or to such person for the damage done or the excess of Gas obtained and 20 used, then it shall be lawful for any Justice of the Peace to summon before him the person against whom any such complaint shall be preferred and for any two or more justices upon hearing the allegations and proofs on both sides or on non appearance of the person complained against (after proof 25 of his being duly summoned) to award such sum of money by way of damages to the Company or to such person as the case may require and the said Justices may deem reasonable, together with the costs and in case of a neglect or refusal to pay any sum or sums so awarded within three days after such 30 award, it shall be lawful for any one of the said Justices to issue his warrant to cause the same to be levied of the goods

XXIII. And be it enacted, that if any person or persons, Company may company or companies or body corporate supplied with Gas stop gas in 35 by the Company, shall neglect to pay any rate, rent or charge payment due to them at any of the times of payment thereof, it shall be lawful for the company or any person acting under their authority to stop the Gas from entering the premises, service pipes or lamps of any such person, company or body by 40 cutting off the service pipe or pipes or by such means as the said Company shall think fit and to recover the said rate, rent or charge, together with the expenses of cutting off the Gas; in any competent Court by action of debt.
