A merchant. Is a dir. of the Central Bank of Canada and Vice Presdt. of the Haggart Manufacturing Co. Has been Warden of the Co and Reeve of Brampton. First returned to Leg. Assem. for present seat, 19 Feb. 1873, on death of sitting mem.; re-elected at g. e. 1875. Unseated on petition 14 June, 1875, but judgment subsequently reversed on appeal. Re-elected at g. e. 1879, 1883, and again at last g. e. A Liberal, and supporter of Mr. Mowat.—Alderlea, Brampton, Ont,
