
MARRIAGE—*Continued.*

Rule 19, 193. Debate resumed; Amendment negatived; Amendment moved by Sir A. Smith, to postpone the consideration of the Bill for six months, 195. Negatived; Amendment moved to recommit the Bill, by Mr. Strange, so as to provide for the marriage of a woman with the brother of her deceased husband; Negatived; Amendment moved by Mr. McCuaig that the Bill be recommitted for the purpose of providing that no clergyman shall be obliged to perform a marriage ceremony if the woman be a sister of the man's deceased wife; Negatived, 196. Bill considered; Motion for third reading; Amendment moved by Mr. Amyot, that the Federal Parliament has no jurisdiction to legislate on the qualities required to contract marriage; Negatived; Amendment moved by Mr. Strange respecting marriage of a woman with the brother of her deceased husband, 197. Negatived; Bill read a third time and passed, 198. By the Senate, 291. R.A., 516. (45 Vic., c. 42.)

Members admitted to their seats (after taking Oath) on production of certificate of Returning Officer only; Resolution that in admitting them to take their seats on production of such writs only, the House still recommends a strict adherence to the practice of requiring the usual certificate, 90, 242.
4. Motion, that the Members of this Parliament should be elected under a Franchise, the creation of the Law of the Dominion, &c.; Debate thereon adjourned, 126.
