

I look on the proposed arrangement as one of great public advantage as assisting materially the new Settlement and I think it should be assented to without delay as well in respect to the relinquishment of the proposed purchase as by authorizing the Indian Department to repay the Government expenditure and to expend upon the road to the extent of \$300.

Some of the Emigrants can be employed upon this road, and as in that part of the country labour is considerably in demand - I have no doubt that the first temporary employment would cause most of those engaged in it to become resident settlers in the neighbourhood.
