Dear Mr. Fielding:-

In regard to the new duties on ARTIFICIAL SILK
and articles manufactured therefrom, we would submit the following:

- (1) That the duties be left in the tariff but not put into operation until such time as ARTIFICIAL SILK is manufactured in Canada in production quantity.
- (2) That stockings and socks which are manufactured from ARTIFICIAL SILK or of which ARTIFICIAL SILK is a component part of chief value, be specifically mentioned in Tariff Item 583 d, so that they will not come under item 568a on which the tariff is, British Preferential 22½%, Intermediate 32½% and General 35%.
